The below points are an outline of the approach to be taken in order to tackle speeding in the Parish of Bix and Assendon. The purpose of which will be to produce an overarching solution, which will likely include the implementation of a combination of physical interventions working together in order to reduce speeding and to achieve traffic calming within the community

Phase 1: Desk study

The WG will aim to assess the parish and identify sites of concern and possible suitable intervention combinations – this activity will include referring to

- Google earth
- local road maps

Phase 2: Physical assessment

A parish wide physical inspection of the road network conducted by the WG to confirm locations identified and identify further locations is applicable. WG to discuss suitable intervention options/combinations which may be applicable

Phase 3: Local Government site meeting

WG to meet local government agencies such as the SODC/OCC on site to discuss possible solutions as identified above

Phase 4: Feasibility plan

WG to compile a feasibility plan to include the implementations identified vs. cost, implementation timelines and fundraising (grants etc)

Phase 5: Report to Parish Council

Present findings and recommendations to the PC

Phase 6: Parish Council feedback

Taking feedback from the PC and providing replies where possible

Phase 7: Replies

WG to present replies/solutions to the issues/feedback raised by the PC.

Phase 8: Issuance of 'Over-arching Traffic Calming Plan'

WG to draw up overarching plan for PC approval based upon the above activities and outcomes

Phase 9: Community communication

PC to carry out parish-wide communications to inform as many residents as possible of the 'Over-arching Traffic Calming Plan' via BAG, WhatsApp, Facebook and in a physical open meeting.

Phase 10: Funding options etc

WG to investigate funding options and put together a plan for a phased approach for intervention implementation where appropriate
